Guidance for Visiting Supporters

A few ideas for reducing the carbon footprint of your journey to watch your team:

1. In these days of rising costs, how about taking your bicycle out of the garage ? Too far ? Well, one of the Sutton fans cycled to every away league game during the 2010/11 season. The Borough Sports Ground has secure cycle racks by the main entrance to the stadium.
2. It's really convenient to come to The Borough Sports Ground by train, West Sutton station is only 100 yards down the road. The First Capital Connect service runs from London Bridge and crosses London to St Albans. Trains also run to Victoria and link directly to Sutton and Wimbledon stations.
3. The 413 bus runs right past our front gate and links Sutton station with Morden underground. If you are feeling a bit more energetic, the 151 and 213 buses run along Cheam Road from Sutton and stop at the end of Gander Green Lane, just a five minute walk from the stadium. The 213 runs from Kingston to Sutton and the 151 runs between Wallington and Worcester Park.
4. If there are enough of you, then travel by coach is not only fun, it can be relatively cheap and reduces everyone's carbon footprint.
5. Not enough to fill a full coach, then how about hiring a minibus ?
6. If you have to drive, try not to travel alone. Come with friends or family, or maybe try to set up a car-pool scheme so that you can share the driving from week to week.
