- § Communicate professionally with parents, players, and staff on a regular basis.
- § Responsibility of managing the transitioning of YDP players into PDP.
- § Attend required YDP match day venues and ensure match day planning is maintained.
- § Arrange additional games as deemed necessary to reach KPIs per Phase
- § Organise and conduct the multi-disciplinary reviews every 6 weeks for the U13-16 age groups.
