Sutton United Football Club History (2)

Sutton United Football Club, founded in 1898 through the merger of Sutton Association and Sutton Guild Rovers, has a rich history spanning over 125 years. Known for their amber and chocolate colours, the club gained early success in local competitions before rising to prominence in the amateur game.

The **Stadium**



- The VBS Community Stadium is located just off Gander Green Lane.
- · Home fans can enter through the stadium via gate A and C. Gate A is accessible directly off Gander Green Lane at the front of the stadium. Here you can find our Club Shop, where you can buy club merchandise.
- · Home fans can also enter via gate C, off Collingwood Park. These turnstiles will take you directly into the home Fanzone, where a variety of food and drink options can be found.

Getting Here

By Car:



Travel along the M25 to junction 8. Then north on the A217 for about 15-20 minutes. Stay on the A217 to the traffic lights with the Cheam Road (A232) and turn right toward Sutton. Do not turn into Gander Green Lane, keep going until you reach the Sutton one-way system and turn left into St Nicholas Way and then left again into the Gibson Road municipal car-park. It is then a relatively short walk down Collingwood Road to the away end of the stadium.

By Public Transport:



Two buses between Morden and Sutton stations run conveniently close to our stadium: route 413 bus goes down Gander Green Lane, and number 80 runs along Collingwood Road. The ground can then be reached by taking the path through Collingwood Rec. London Buses are now cashless.

Our closest station to the stadium is West Sutton station (about a 3 minute walk from the stadium). Fans can also arrive via the more well connected Sutton Station (about 15 minute walk from the stadium)

Parking



- We do not offer general admission parking. On matchdays, the club car park in Gander Green Lane is for parking permir holders only.
- Away fans should park in Gibson Road, the local municipal car park. It takes no more than 15 minutes to walk from Gibson Road to the stadium.

Over the years, Sutton United has become known for their FA Cup exploits, including a famous victory over Coventry City in 1989 and a memorable run to the 5th round in 2017, where they faced Arsenal.

After fluctuating between leagues, Sutton earned promotion to the Football League for the first time in 2021. Off the pitch, the club is deeply rooted in the local community, with ongoing ground improvements at Gander Green Lane and a commitment to providing facilities for local teams. 

Home Pub



The Rowlen's Bar, located within the main stand, is open to all and offers a variety of drinks, including cask ales from Heineken. The bar is open every matchday, with adjusted hours for midweek games.

Prohibited Items



- Weapons or dangerous items, including knives, blades, flares, fireworks, smoke canisters, air horns, laser devices, and similar items
- Bottles, glass vessels, cans, drums, poles, or any article that may be used as a weapon or compromise safety
- Bags larger than an average rucksack (48cm × 33cm) – such items will not be permitted entry
- No dogs, except licensed assistance dogs
- Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is banned inside the stadium
- Use of threatening behaviour, foul or discriminatory language or chanting, throwing objects, or entering the pitch area is strictly forbidden

FAQs (?)

I bought my ticket online and received a confirmation of purchase but no e-ticket. Can you help?

Of course, please email tickets@suttonunited.net. They'll just have to resend it to you, which only takes a few minutes.

Can I buy tickets at the stadium on matchday?

Yes, you can purchase tickets from the ticket booth at the front of the stadium only for the current matchday. Tickets at the ticket booth are £3 more. Digital sales are also available in advance and on matchday and any ticket prices remain.

I want to bring my baby/toddler to Sutton United. Do they go free?

Yes, you're very welcome to bring along your baby or toddler. If your little one is under 3, please just drop us a quick note at tickets@suttonunited.net so we can make the arrangements. For children aged 3–13, U14 tickets are available from just £2.

I am a carer to a friend/family member who would like to come watch Sutton United play. Can you accommodate us?

If eligible, you are entitled to a free carer ticket to go along with the person you are accompanying. If you'd like to purchase a carer matchday or season ticket online, please email tickets@suttonunited.net. They will add a special tag to your account that will allow you to get a free carer ticket.

I'm in a wheelchair but I'd like to come to a match. Do you have accessible facilities?

Yes! We have a wheelchair bay pitch side for those in wheelchairs. This space is limited so in order to ensure you get a spot, email dave.farebrother@suttonunited.net. He will make sure you have access to accessible facilities. Other than that, tickets can be purchased as normal.
