



## SUTTON UNITED FC

### GREEN TRAVEL PLAN

This Plan is intended as an advisory document, an aid to spectators who would like to decrease their carbon footprint.

As one of the few clubs that attempts to quantify carbon impacts of spectators travelling to games, and were possibly the first to do so, we understand that travel is a very significant element, if not the largest element, of a club's total footprint; even if spectator travel is not considered to be part of a club's Scope 3 footprint.

- 1 Walk to the stadium  
Walking has zero carbon impact.
- 2 Cycle to the stadium  
Cycling has zero carbon impact and cycle parking is available.
- 3 Take the bus  
The 413 bus stops close to the main entrance in Gander Green Lane, and links Sutton's main line station to Morden underground station.  
Several buses stop at Sutton Green, near the bus garage which is 300m behind our Collingwood Road goal, including routes:-  
80 - Downview Prison to Hackbridge  
151 - Wallington to Worcester Park  
213 - Kingston to Sutton  
280 - Belmont Station to St George's Hospital
- 4 Take the train  
West Sutton station shares a fence with our ground, it is a 150m walk from the station to our main entrance. However, West Sutton does not have step-free access or other facilities for passengers with disabilities.  
Sutton station is a mile away and is linked by the 413 bus. It is a main line station with frequent services from London Bridge or Victoria to Epsom, Horsham and Guildford. Network Rail state that it is fully accessible.
- 5 Supporters' Coach  
For away fans, if your club runs coaches to away games for supporters then the carbon footprint per passenger is greatly reduced.
- 6 Electric Vehicles  
An EV has zero carbon emissions at point of use and also complies with the emissions requirements in Sutton and Greater London. There are almost 30 charging points in the local area, including one in the stadium car park that does need to be pre-booked and is not generally available on match days. - 7 Car Share  
Why use four cars when you use one ? Sharing the journey with other spectators not only saves unnecessary carbon, its cheaper.
- 8 Petrol or diesel vehicles  
We recognise that for some people driving is the only option. Parking at the stadium is fully booked across the season but we do have spaces reserved for blue badge holders, to enquire about booking a space email [info@suttonunited.net](mailto:info@suttonunited.net). For anyone who doesn't mind a short walk, parking is available at the municipal car park in Gibson Road.  
To be fuel efficient, always ensure your tyres are at the correct pressure before you set off.

Remember that Sutton is covered by the ULEZ scheme and also that many roads in the borough are limited to 20 mph.
